Dear Log Book Sculler;

Thank you for signing up for Logbook Sculling with Essex Rowing Association. We are very excited about the coming rowing season. The transition from Essex Rowing Club to Essex Rowing Association will be a work in progress, therefore, please be patient as we work things out. At this time you will need to issue 2 checks as we transition, Rack Space rental to Essex Rowing Club, Logbook Sculling to Essex Rowing Association, See Below.

Please keep in mind that as a "Membership Run Club" you have a say in what goes on and will have the opportunity to join a committee or be on the board which will come with responsibility. More on this later as we settle in.

We will be following US Rowing guidelines for safety and expectations. In addition I have listed below important information.

1. Sculling Hours– Season May 15th to October 31st, tentative, 5:30 AM to 8:00 PM, Monday to Sunday. Subject to water and air conditions.
2. Boat House Access—Keys kept in a lock box, The boathouse must be locked at all times.
3. Rack Space Rental– \$350, To Essex Rowing Club, PO Box 81, North Andover, MA 01845 I don't anticipate a wait list, however, it will be on first come first serve basis. Private boats may only be moved by owner or with his/her permission.
4. Log Book Sculling– \$250, To Essex Rowing Association, 29 Bartlet St., Andover, MA 01810
5. Liability and Insurance– The club can not be liable to any damage to your boat or personal injury, therefore, please carry worst case insurance. Please send a copy of your policy with your payment for our files.
6. Safety– There is an inherent risk in sculling and you must be prepared for the worst. As adults, each one of us assumes the risk we are taking. We recommend the attached guidelines to assure your safety. However, at the end of the day your safety is up to you.
7. US Rowing Membership– You must be at least a Basic Member (\$9.75) with US Rowing and sign the liability waiver. <http://www.usrowing.org>
8. Maintenance– From time to time we will need help in repairing and maintaining the facility for the benefit of all. ie. Flags to keep the geese off the docks, etc.
