






**GENERAL RULES:**

1. IT IS ABOUT 4K FROM THE LAUNCH DOCK TO THE MARSHALLING AREA. ALLOW PLENTY OF TIME TO GET TO YOUR EVENT ON TIME.
2. ONCE ON THE RACE COURSE, SLOWER BOATS MUST GIVE WAY BY MOVING TOWARD THE CENTER OF THE RIVER.
3. ROWING IN THE TRAVEL LANE SHOULD BE AS CLOSE TO SHORE AS IS SAFELY POSSIBLE. PASSING IN THE TRAVEL LANE SHOULD BE DONE WITH EXTREME CAUTION. MOVE TO SHORE ONCE YOU'VE PASSED THE SLOWER BOAT. BOATS ROWING TO THE START SHOULD NOT BE IN THE MIDDLE OF THE RIVER.
4. ALL BOATS MUST ADHERE TO COMMANDS GIVEN BY RACE OFFICIALS.

  1. ROW WITH EXTREME CAUTION AND IN SINGLE FILE WHEN LEAVING THE LAUNCH DOCK UP THE ISLAND CHANNEL. NO PASSING IS ALLOWED IN THE CHANNEL. THERE ARE HAZARDS IN THE CHANNEL ALONG THE UPRIVER ISLAND SHORE.
  2. AS YOU APPROACH THE MARSHALLING AREA JUST PRIOR TO THE POWER LINES, STAY AS CLOSE TO THE METHUEN SHORE AS IS SAFELY POSSIBLE. NO PASSING IS ALLOWED IN THE TRAVEL LANE IN THIS AREA.

  1. ONCE ON THE COURSE, THERE ARE EXPOSED ROCKS AND FALLEN TREES IN THE RIVER JUST PAST THE POWER LINES AND AROUND THE FIRST STARBOARD TURN. STAYING ABOUT 6-7 METERS FROM SHORE WILL PROVIDE SAFE PASSAGE.
  2. THERE ARE FALLEN TREES IN THE RIVER AS YOU MAKE THE STARBOARD TURN AROUND THE BEND TO THE FINISH LINE. TAKING THIS TURN ABOUT 6-7 METERS FROM SHORE WILL GET YOU SAFELY AROUND.
